



Bible Tracker Registration Guide

What an unregistered Bible Tracker user should expect when creating an account and setting a password.

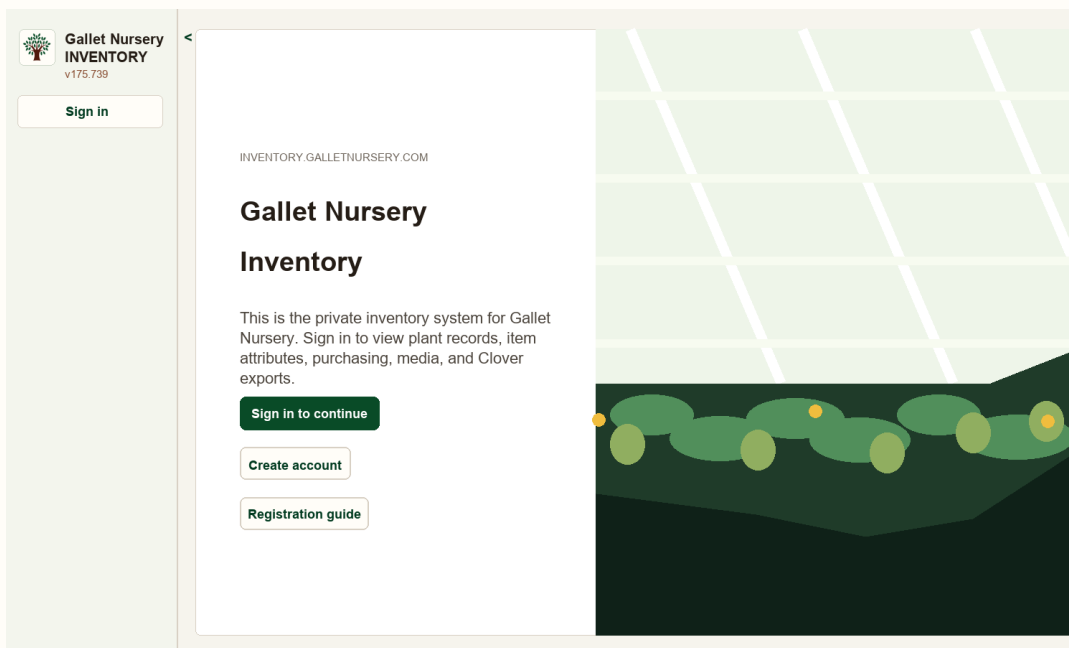
Quick Start

- Click the hyperlink: **Inventory.GalletNursery.com**. This opens the public sign-in page.
- Click **Create account**. This opens the Bible Tracker Access form.
- **Enter email and display name**. The display name is how the account appears inside Bible Tracker.
- **Check your email**. GNS sends a secure setup link so you can choose your own password.
- **Set your password**. The setup link opens the Set password screen. Passwords must be at least 8 characters.
- **Sign in**. After setup, use the Sign in button with your email and password.

Setup links expire after 72 hours. Password reset links expire after 24 hours. Treat both links like passwords and do not forward them.

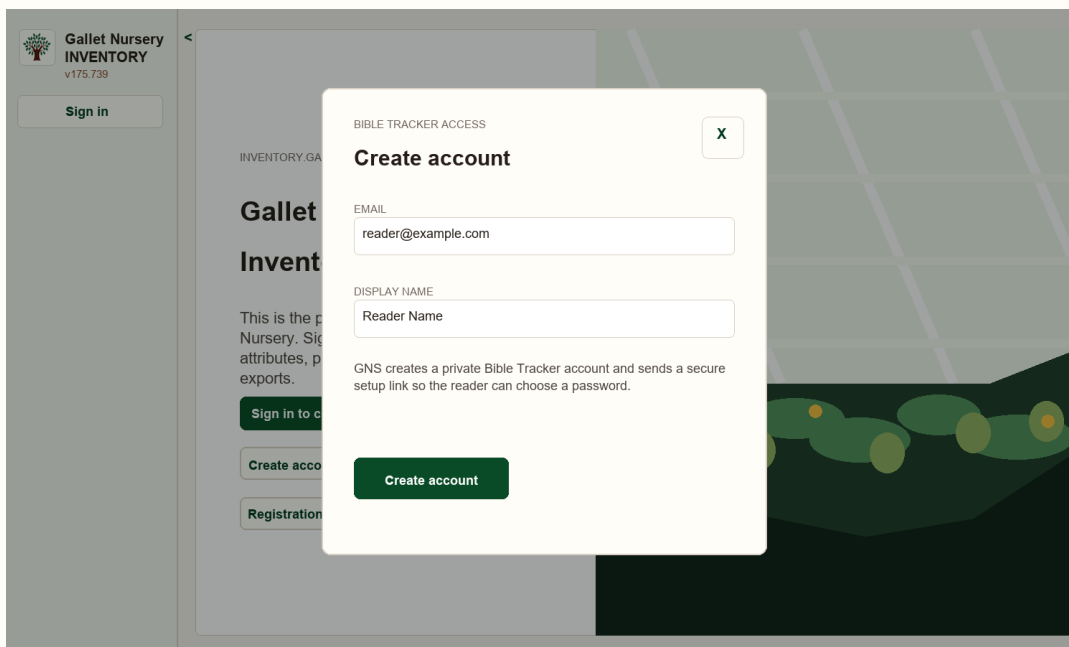
Starting Point

Use the public entry screen to sign in or begin account creation.



Step 1: Create The Account

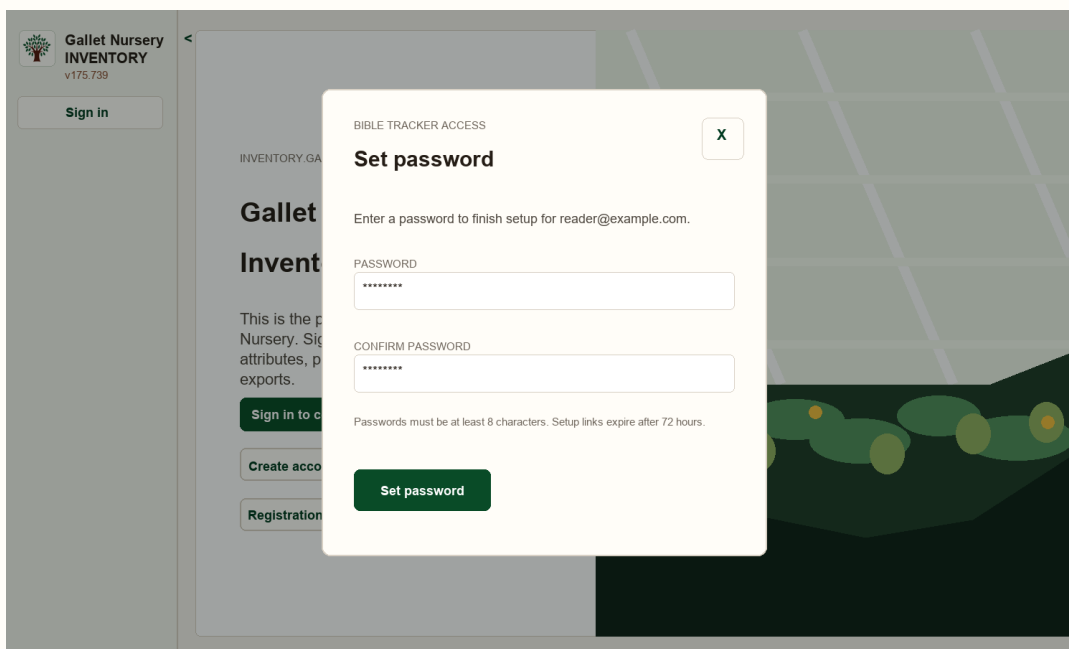
Click **Create account**, enter the reader's email address, and optionally enter a display name. GNS creates a private Bible Tracker account and prepares a secure password setup link.

Step 2: Use The Setup Link

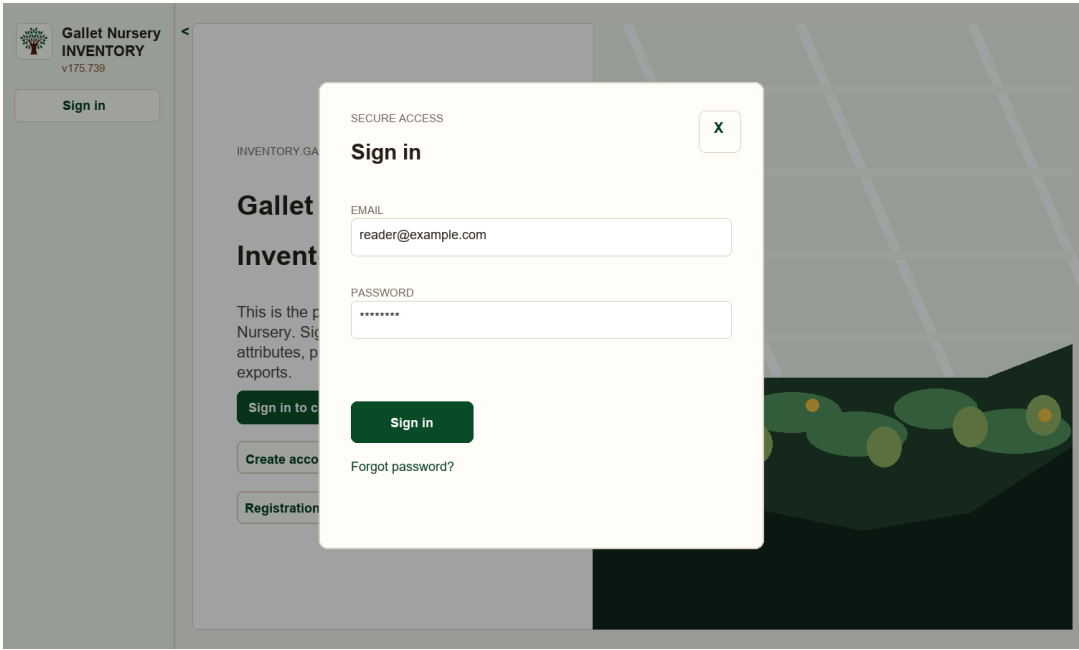
After account creation, open the setup link from email. The link is tied to the account and opens the Set password screen. Enter the password twice and submit it to finish setup.

Step 3: Sign In

Return to the site and click **Sign in**. Use the email address and password created during setup. If the password is forgotten later, use **Forgot password?** to request a reset link.



What Access Includes

- Bible Tracker reading progress, active books, chapter counts, notes, and highlights.
- Reader features such as API reading windows, font controls, footnotes, chapter navigation, and persistent reader sizing.
- Private account history so each user's notes and reading records remain attributed by user and date.

Common Questions

Question	Answer
What if the setup link expires?	Ask for a new setup link or use the password reset flow if the account is already active.
Can I change my password later?	Yes. Sign in, open the account menu, and choose Change password.
What if I do not receive the email?	Check spam/junk folders first. Then ask the GNS administrator to confirm the email address and send a fresh link.
Can I share my setup link?	No. Setup and reset links grant account access and should stay private.
